

## **CONTINUING EDUCATION INFORMATION FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE LICENSED PSYCHOLOGISTS**

### **Do I need to attend CEs in person?**

No. While there are “live” requirements for training, “live” means that you can interact with the presenter at the time of the presentation, either in-person or online.

### **Does Ethics training have to be LIVE?**

No, according to the current rules, there is no requirement that the 6 Ethics CEs must be “live” but they have to be from an approved organization.

### **What are the required CEs for license renewal?**

- All psychologists need to earn 40 hours of CE credit in their two-year period
- 20 out of the 40 hours can be homestudy (meaning reading a book/journal or watching recorded webinar that has a corresponding quiz)
- 20 out of the 40 hours have to be interactive (either live or in person)
- Up to 10 out of the 40 can be for preparation of seminar or workshop
- Up to 10 out of 40 can be preparation of teaching a new semester length course
- Up to 20 hours can be providing service as a professional conduct investigation committee member
- 6 out of the 40 credits have to be Ethics CE AND offered through one of the approved organizations (APA, NHPA, AMA, AAMFT, etc – see full list on online)
- Up to 10 out of the 40 credits can be Category B (informal) can be hours spent researching or writing articles in the practice of psychology, providing mental health workshops to the public, teaching graduate or non-graduate course (only 5 credits per year)

### **How do I count my hours towards CEs when reading a book/journal or watching a webinar?**

You can only use journal article/book reading or watching a webinar for CE if they have a corresponding quiz to “test attendance”. These are called homestudies. Each

homestudy will have a corresponding number of CEs attached, which you can earn by completing the homestudy AND taking/passing the corresponding quiz.

**Do I need to upload my CEs?**

No, you do not need to provide copies of your CEs at the time of license renewal. Please hold onto them as the BoP will randomly choose licensed psychologists each year for an audit in which you will have to provide the documents at that time only.

**How do I track my peer collaboration hours?**

Keep track of your required collaboration hours (40 hours per licensing renewal period) with dates and times and hold onto them in case you are randomly chosen for an audit. For more information on what is required for collaboration hours, please see rule 403.02
